SUBJECT: ALSSA Campaign Plan 2024-2025

- 1. The Air Land Sea Space Application Center provides joint solutions for tactical warfighters by filling gaps in existing tactics, techniques, and procedures to improve near-term interoperability and ensure victory in the next battle.
- 2. Outreach, warfighter engagement, and the production of multi-Service tactics, techniques, and procedures (MTTP) remain focus areas of ALSSA daily operations.
- 3. The ALSSA catalog of 29 MTTP are prioritized with 10 foundational MTTP supporting large-scale combat operations, alongside routine MTTP supporting multiple other types of operations. These MTTP are all scheduled for review based on a 1 to 5 year cycle and continually monitored for major changes that could require out-of-cycle revisions. The CY2024-2025 Campaign Plan for ALSSA is attached.
